

Results of elections in Namibia and Botswana

At the end of 2019, national elections were held almost simultaneously in two southern African states - Namibia and Botswana. On March 21, 2020, on the day of the celebration of the 30th anniversary of the country's independence, the inauguration of the re-elected President of Namibia, Hage Geingoba, took place. And earlier, on November 1, 2019, - the inauguration of the President of Botswana Mokvetsi Masisi. More details.

2020 presidential election in Togo

On February 22, 2020, the presidential elections were held in Togo. In accordance with the amendments to the Constitution adopted in May 2019, the so-called "absolute majority" system was introduced in presidential elections. According to it the candidate who received 50% + 1 vote is considered the winner, instead of the previously used "relative majority" scheme, when the winner went to the candidate with the highest number of votes. The current geopolitical situation in the Sahel

At the end of 2019, the American edition of The New York Times reported that the head of the Pentagon, Mark Esper, is considering the possibility of reducing or completely withdrawing American troops from the countries of Sub-Saharan Africa. It became known that he ordered the African Command of the US Armed Forces (Africa) to prepare a comprehensive plan for the withdrawal of troops from the Sahel. <u>More details</u>.

COVID-19 epidemic in South Africa (February-April 2020)

More than 20% of all confirmed cases of a new form of coronavirus in the African continent were detected in South Africa. As of April 17, 2,783 infected with COVID-19 were registered in South Africa, 50 died and 903 recovered. More cases were confirmed only in Egypt (2844), at the same time Morocco and Algeria are slightly behind South Africa on this indicator - 2670 and 2418 infected, respectively. More details.

Guinea: parliamentary elections and referendum on amendments to the Constitution, 22 March 2020

On March 22, parliamentary elections and a referendum on constitutional amendments were held in Guinea. Their term of office as parliamentarians of the previous convocation, elected in 2013, expired almost two years ago, but in early 2019 the powers of the deputies were extended indefinitely by decree of President Alfa Conde. Fighting COVID-19 Pandemic and Its Aftermath in Egypt

According to the World Health Organization, since February 14, 2020, when the first confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus was detected in Egypt, a total of 9,746 cases were registered until May 12, of which 533 have died. The spread of the new coronavirus infection in Egypt has become a serious test for the national health system, represented by both government and private medical institutions. <u>More details</u>.

2020 elections in Cameroon and the Anglophone crisis

On February 9, 2020, elections were held for the lower house of the Cameroonian parliament - the National Assembly (NA). It consists of 180 deputies elected by direct universal suffrage of the country's population for a 5-year term. The territory of the Republic of Cameroon is divided into 49 multi- and single-member districts. More details.

Visit of V.I. Matvienko the Republic of Zambia and the Republic of Namibia in February 2020

On February 17-22, 2020, a delegation of the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation, headed by its Chairman V.I. Matvienko, paid an official visit to the Republics of Zambia and Namibia. The visit took place within the framework of the parliamentary consultations mechanism between Russia and African countries. Parliamentary elections in Mali: tensions in the country continue

Parliamentary elections were held in Mali: the first round - March 29, the second - April 19 this year. Mali became the second African country to hold elections, despite the coronavirus pandemic announced by the World Health Organization (WHO) on March 11 (parliamentary elections and a constitutional referendum were held in Guinea on March 22). <u>More details</u>.

COVID-19 epidemic in Nigeria

Coronavirus in Nigeria was detected on February 27, 2020. As of June 7, there were 12,233 people infected with coronavirus infection in the country, 342 people died, 3,826 recovered. Thus, in terms of the number of infected, Nigeria was in third place in Africa, lagging behind South Africa (45 973) and Egypt (32 612). <u>More details</u>.


African politics in Paris in the context of the pandemic


