XXIV St. Petersburg International Economic Forum

From 2 to 5 June 2021, St. Petersburg hosted the XXIV St. Petersburg International Economic Forum, which became the world's first and largest full-time business event after a forced break due to the coronavirus pandemic. This year it was attended by 13 thousand participants. About 800 transactions were concluded for a total of 3.8 trillion rub. One of the most important discussion platforms of the forum - Russia - Africa, was called upon to determine the most important areas of Russian-African cooperation in the near future.

The moderator of the Russia - Africa discussion platform was Irina Olegovna Abramova, Director of the Institute for African Studies of the Russian Academy of

General Election in the Republic of Niger 2020

On December 27, 2020, a general election was held in the Republic of Niger: the President and the National Assembly of the country were elected.

Niger is one of the poorest countries in the world, with 41.4% of its population below the poverty line. Up to 80% of the territory is occupied by the Sahara Desert; the rest of the regions located in the Sahel are prone to droughts and desertification. Most of the 24 million people live in the far west and south of the country, where natural conditions allow

for full-fledged agricultural activities. Significant reserves of minerals (gold, zinc, lead, silver, tin, etc.) have been discovered and partially developed in Niger, but its main wealth is uranium, for which the country ranks fifth in the world. Read more...



Ethiopia: 125 years of victory over the Italian colonialists at the Battle of Adua (1896)

On March 2, 2021, in Addis Ababa, on the main square - Meskel - near the monument to Emperor Menelik II, celebrations were held to mark the 125th anniversary of the victory of Ethiopia (then Abyssinia) over the Italian colonialists at Adua. The victory of Abyssinia, including the irregular peasant army under the command of Emperor Menelik II, received a huge resonance in the world as the first victory against a colonial power ever won by an African country. The small country, which was considered "barbaric" in Europe, became an equal state. European powers were in a hurry to establish diplomatic

relations and open embassies and missions in Addis Ababa. The victory at Adua was a launching pad or a springboard for the emergence of pan-Africanism. Read more...



March 2021: presidential elections in the Congo Republic

The Republic of the Congo is a former French colony that gained independence on August 15, 1960. For more than 25 years (from July 1964 to December 1990), the Republic of the Congo (then the People's Republic of the Congo) developed a course of socialist orientation. In 1990, the country's leadership was one of the first in Africa to declare the beginning of democratic reforms, the need to carry out "restructuring in the Congolese way." In July 1990, the ruling and then the only Congolese Labor Party in the country raised the issue of introducing a multi-party system in the Congo and rejection of

Marxism-Leninism as a state ideology. Read more...



Presidential Election 2021 in the Republic of Benin

On April 11, 2021, presidential elections were held in the Republic of Benin. The current head of state, 63-year-old Patrice Guyem Atanas Talon (born May 1, 1958), who ran as an independent candidate, was re-elected for a second (last) 5-year term, receiving 86.36% (1984 832) of the vote with a turnout of 50.17%. In conjunction with him, Vice-President of Parliament Mariam Chabi Talata Zimé, who became the first woman in Benin's history in this position, was on the post of vice-president. Read more...



Djibouti presidential elections. Situation in the country and forecasts of its development.

The presidential elections in the Republic of Djibouti were held on April 9, 2021. The incumbent President Ismail Omar Gelle, gaining 98.58% of the votes of the registered voters, took over as head of state for the fifth time. On the whole, the elections passed calmly, and in the absence of real opposition to the incumbent president, they had a generally predictable result. The few opposition parties in Djibouti, as before, failed to nominate a single candidate and traditionally boycotted the elections. Read more...



Republic of Chad: before and after the 2021 presidential elections

April 2021 marked a turning point in the history of modern Chad. On April 11, presidential elections were held, demonstrating for the sixth time the advantage of incumbent President Idris Deby (the "Mouvement patriotique du salut" party), who received 79.32% of the vote with a turnout of 64.81% (population of the country – 17.4 million people, about 7.4 million voters are registered). Nine candidates running for the post of head of state could not compete with him. Read more...
