Riots in South Africa: causes and consequences

June 29, 2021 South African Constitutional Court sentenced former president of South Africa and the leader of the ruling party - African National Congress (ANC) -Jacob Zuma to 15 months in prison for "contempt of court", expressed in the refusal to testify during the work of the state commission, unauthorized departure from its meeting, and then refusal to participate in its work. This institution, which bears the official name "Legal Commission to Investigate Allegations of State Capture, Corruption and Fraud in the Public Sector,

Including Organs of the State", was created in early 2018 during the presidency of Zuma himself, although not by his will, but by an order of a public defender, as in South Africa they call the Ombudsman. Read more...



Elections and the ethnopolitical situation in Ethiopia

Parliamentary elections and Sate Legislative Councils elections were held in Ethiopia on June 21, 2021. Elections have never been held in such unfavorable conditions: political crisis in the country, war in Tigray state, pandemic of coronavirus, the beginning of rainy season, which made it difficult to access some remote areas. And yet the elections took place. Originally scheduled for May 5 2020, they were postponed to August 19, 2020, and subsequently canceled due to the pandemic. At the beginning of 2021, a new date was set -

June 5, 2021, however, due to poor preparation, the deadline was postponed to 21 June. Read more...
