# Ceremonial meeting of the Academic Council of the Institute for African Studies dedicated to the Africa Day

#### Participation of the Director of the Institute for African Studies RAS in the General meeting of the Coordination Committee for Economic Cooperation with Sub-Saharan Africa (AfroCom)

On 7 April 2017, the Director of the Institute for African Studies of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Corresponding Member of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Dr.Sc (Econ.) Irina O. Abramova spoke at the General meeting of the Coordination Committee for Economic Cooperation with Sub-Saharan Africa (AfroCom). In the course of the meeting, the election of the Chairman of the Coordination Committee took place. By the decision of the



General Meeting, Pyotr M. Fradkov, General Director of JSC "Russian Export Center" was elected the Chairman of AfroCom. Director of the Institute for African Studies RAS Irina O. Abramova was elected the Vice-Chairman of AfroCom and appointed as Head of the Expert Council of AfroCom. The discussion was attended by the representatives of Russian ministries and departments, business community and the media. The General meeting of AfroCom decided to instruct the Executive Secretariat to formulate a list of promising economic cooperation projects with the countries of sub-Saharan Africa. Read more

On April 21, 2017, Deputy Chairman of the Council of young researchers of the Institute for African Studies RAS, Ph.D. (Econ.) Vasiliy A. Sidorov took part in the seminar-meeting of the young leaders of the BRICS countries held in the Government House of the Moscow region.

The visit to the Government House for the heads of delegations of young leaders of the BRICS countries began with a meeting with the Governor of the Moscow region Andrei Vorobyov. "I welcome all young entrepreneurs, active people who came to the Moscow region under the auspices of

#### St. Petersburg International Economic Forum

## Field research in the first Old Believer communities of Africa

From 13 to 27 of June 2017 Social Anthropologists of the Institute for African Studies: corresponding member of the RAS, Dr. Sc.(Hist), prof. D. Bondarenko (project manager), junior research fellow A. Lapushkina, and the head of the Russian Orthodox Old Believers Church mission in Uganda Priest N. Bobkov worked in the Republic of Uganda (in the capital Kampala and Nakabaale, Kisodzho, Kapeka). This study was the first stage of the three-year scientific project "Orthodox Christians and Old Believers in Uganda: Sociocultural Processes in African Christian Communities" (grant RFBR (Russian Foundation



for Basic Research) 17-01-00148). The aim of the Project is to study the phenomenon of Ugandan Orthodox Christianity and Old Believers in its socio-cultural aspect. The duration - 2017-2019 (inclusive). The participants plan to give papers and publish academic and popular articles based on the evidence they collected in Uganda.

## Politics of E. Macron in the African direction: estimates and forecasts

During the electoral campaign in 2007, the contender for the presidency of France, Nicolas Sarkozy, promised to revise the African policy in Paris, especially, he promised to change the attitude to the abuses of some dictators. "France will not play the role of gendarme in Africa anymore," Sarkozy said in Cape Town in February 2008. After these promises bombing in Libya followed.

Francois Hollande also arrived at the Elysee Palace with ideas of nonintervention in African affairs. In October 2012, speaking in Dakar, he said that in future Paris would debate with African states on equal terms, and the practice of neocolonialism would be left in the past. "The times which were called "Fransafrique", have passed," he said. However, the crises in Mali and the CAR have made him to change his intentions completely. Read more

## New level in the relationship between the USA and Egypt

Just one month after the inauguration of Donald Trump on January 20, 2017, his administration took the first practical steps to change relations with Egypt radically, which were formed in the days of Barack Obama. That Middle East policy led to their deterioration with practically all states of the region.

The atmosphere of distrust between Washington and Cairo appeared from the beginning of the Arab spring in the country of the pharaohs on 25, 2011, when Americans, in fact, supported "brothers Muslims" who had unsuccessfully fought for power in Egypt before. This was sudden for the Hosni Mubarak who ruled for nearly 30 years, who established the closest ties with the United States. Surely, this was a shock and a serious lesson for the ruling elite in the country, which it probably will not forget soon. Read more
