«Society and Politics in Africa: Traditional, Transitional, and New»: 13th International African Studies Conference

May 27-30, 2014, the Russian Academy of Sciences' Academic council on Africa together with the Institute for African Studies ran the 13th International African Studies Conference «Society and Politics in Africa: Traditional, Transitional, and New» in Moscow.

Among the attendees of the grand opening ceremony were representatives of

African diplomatic Corps and heads of diplomatic missions in Moscow, Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Rossotrudnichestvo senior officials, researchers from Academy of Sciences institutions. The head of the Department of Africa of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Sergey Kryukov; Dean of the African diplomatic Corps, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Madagascar Eloi Alphonse Maxim Duvu; Minister of Foreign Affairs and Regional Cooperation of the Republic of South Sudan, Barnaba Marial Benjamin – delivered welcome speeches; the keynote speaker Prof. Irina Abramova made a presentation «New role of Africa in the world economy in XXI century».



Conference working days

The Conference working sessions continued in 53 panels forming 8 blocks: economics, politics and society, environment, history and anthropology, international relations, linguistics, media and information, regional issues, culture and religion. Besides, three Free communication panels were formed for those themes going beyond the scope of the existing ones.

The Forum gathered more than 370 participants from 50 countries. Russian Federation was represented by delegates from 10 cities: Moscow, Saint-Petersburg, Yaroslavl, Kirov, Kazan, Krasnodar, Voronezh, Tambov, Nizhniy Novgorod, Ekaterinburg. Africanists from Almaty and Donetsk represented the Commonwealth of Independent States.

152 foreign researches from all the continents took part in the event: Africa, Europe, Asia, North and South America, Australia. List of participating countries: Australia, Austria, Algeria, Benin, Brazil, Denmark, Ethiopia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Ghana, Great Britain, Hungary, Iceland, India, Iran, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Ivory Coast, Japan, Kenya, Lebanon, Lesotho, Lithuania, Malawi, Mauritius, Morocco, Mozambique, Netherlands, Nigeria, Norway, Poland, Portugal, San Marino, Somalia, South Africa, Sudan, Syria, Switzerland, Sweden, Tanzania, Turkey, USA, Zimbabwe.

Dr. Bekkin in Vienna

By the invitation of the <u>Department</u> of Law of the University of Vienna, on the 16th of June Dr. Rinat Bekkin, a senior research fellow of the Centre for Global and Strategic Studies delivered a lecture on «Islamic finance in non-Islamic countries: a case of Russia». The lecture gathered stuff and students of the University of Vienna and caused an intensive discussion.

June 18, Dr. Bekkin gave a <u>master-class</u> «Islamic Banking and Finance» for students of the <u>University of Graz</u> in the framework of «Re-Visiting the Euro-Islam Debate. Legal Advances and Challenges Ahead» <u>roundtable</u>. Several students expressed an intention to conduct a research on Islamic finance under the supervision of Dr. Bekkin.

June 19 to 22 by the invitation of the Department of Law of the University of Graz Rinat Bekkin did a research devoted to the nowadays tendencies in Islamic finance development. The results of the survey will be published on the University website.

A. Panov's trip to the Great African Lakes region

5th April – 5th May the trip of J.R.F. of The Centre for History and Cultural Anthropology Alexander Panov to the states of Great African Lakes region was performed.

The main purpose of the trip was the participation in events of the «Kwibuka 20» cycle, dedicated to the 20th anniversary of the Tutsi genocide in 1994 in Rwanda. A.
