Russia - South Africa round table

On the 1st of October a round table «Russia-South Africa: building bridges», dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the African National Congress of South Africa, South Africa's ruling party since 1994, was held at the National Research University - Higher School of Economics. The meeting was attended by scholars from the Institute for African Studies: Prof. V. Shubin, Dr. A. Arkhangelskaya, Dr. V. Usacheva, A. Khamatshin. Among the invited persons were: Full Member of the Russian Academy of Sciences Prof. A. Davidson, Prof. I. Filatova, Ambassador of South Africa to Russia Mandisi Mpahlwa. Field research

In October-November 2012 Dr. Daria Zelenova visited South Africa by the invitation of the School of Social Sciences of the University of the Witwatersrand (Johannesburg). The research project «The phenomenon of self-organization as an example of communities in South Africa in the historical and contemporary context» was supported by the Russian Humanitarian Scientific Foundation grant № 11-31-00360. It was her second trip to South Africa as a part of research conducted under the guidance of Olga Aksyutina, a senior research fellow at the Center for Civilisational and Regional Studies. In Johannesburg Daria has worked in the leading country's archives storing materials devoted to the struggle against apartheid, in particular: Historical Papers Archive of the University of the Witwatersrand and the South African History Archive (SAHA). In addition to working with archival data, Daria held a series of interviews in Johannesburg and Durban with township and informal settlements residents, members of present protest movements, political activists, members of the

youth, trade union and public organizations of the 1980s.



The XIth School of Young Africanists

November 14-15, The XIth School of Young Africanists «Problems of African Studies in Russia and abroad» was held at the <u>Institute of Oriental Studies and International Relations</u> (IOSIR) of <u>Kazan (Volga Region) Federal University</u> (KVRFU). The 10th Anniversary Session of the World Public Forum «Dialogue of Civilizations» was held on the Greek island of Rhodes from the 3rd to the 8th of October 2012 and was devoted to the problems of global transformations.

Chairman of the Center of geoeconomic research of the Institute for African Studies (North-South Lab) Alexander Neklessa delivered two reports: «Transformations of the future» and «Nortern Romea. A complex dialog space».

African Studies Conference in Pavia (Italy)

Inter-Institutional Collaboration



From October 26 to November 24, 2012, the research fellow of the Centre for Southern Africa studies Dr. A. Arkhangelskaya visited South Africa and Angola within the framework of the research project «Understanding Russia's Africa engagement: Complementaries and competition between South Africa and Russia» with the South African Institute of International Affairs.

The project is devoted to the activities of the Russian and South African business on the continent, particularly in the case of corporate activity in South Africa and Angola. The research included the interviews were done with Russian, South African and Angolan scientific, governmental and

business organizations' representatives, as well as the representatives of the related diasporas.



Russian-Indian conference in Mumbai

On the 29th of November the group of Russian africanists headed by the full member of the RAS Alexey Vasiliev, took part in the Russian-Indian conference «New Actors and Diaspora as Important Factors in Africa's International Relations and Development» held in Mumbai, India.
