Call for panel proposals – 1 April 2020 to 31 May 2020

The organizing commission of the 3rd International Conference Activisms in Africa invites to all interested in submitting a thematic panel proposal. The commission receives proposal from 1 April 2020 to 31 May 2020.

The panels must dialogue with one of the six thematic axes of the conference and propose a discussion about and between the activism movements in the African continent:

Axe 1: Activism, Social Movements and Politics

- Resistance and social contestation
- Activism and process of democratization
- Rethink the dimension of Politic in Africa

Axe 2: Activism, Land and Environment

- Social movements and the right to the land
- Social movements and sustainable environmental management
- Social movements and megaprojects
- Social movements and solidarity and resistance networks: national, continental and transnational

Axe 3: Activism and Peace

- African social movements and Peace
- Social movements, internal conflicts and transnational threats
- Transnational networks for Peace

Axe 4: Activism and Human Rights

- Political rights
- Social rights
- Civil rights
- Cultural rights



Axe 5: Diaspora and Transnational Networks

- Transnational activism networks
- Continental activism networks and South-South
- Activism movements in Diaspora

Axe 6: Activism and Art

- Visual Arts
- Cinema
- Music and Performative Arts
- Literature

Interdisciplinary contributions or panels that aims to receive paper with strong empirical component are most welcome.

The working languages of the conference are Portuguese, English and French. The panel proposal must be submitted in one of those languages. For those in Portuguese and French, a translation in English must be provided. Scholars and activists may submit up to two panel proposals. In the case of similar proposals, the organizing commission may suggest its junction to the respective authors.

The panel proposal must observe the following:

- 1) Title of the panel and identification of the proponent(s);
- 2) Institutional affiliations;
- 3) Abstracts up to 500 words;
- 4) 3 to 5 keywords.

The organizing commission will communicate the acceptance of the panels until 30 June 2020.
